Supplementary Regulations

1. Jurisdiction: A Hare and Hound event for solo motorcycles held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Standing Regulations, these supplementary regulations and any Final instructions that may be issued for the meeting. Full details are available from the ACU handbook.
2. Eligibility: Open solo (Enduro, Trail and Moto-X) motorcycles. Working lights are not required. **ACU licence required**, ACU day licence available £10.00.
3. Venue: HETHFELTON FOREST, near Wool, Dorset. Entrance off A352 Wareham – Wool road.
4. Course: Approximately 5 1/2 miles consisting of mixed Forest terrain and open Forest tracks.
5. Classes: Championship, Expert, Over 40, Clubman 4, Clubman 2, Sportsman,
6. Machine Examination : 0930 -1015 a.m.

Sound testing @ 94 Decibels, If we all run at this level it's fair for all, loud bikes will be treated the same as course cutting - exclusion.

Riders must produce (clean) Bike, Helmet and Fire extinguisher (No extinguisher no refueling). Numbers: must be displayed front and sides.

7. **TYRES: REAR TRIALS**, front no restriction. (19 inch rear may use speedway tyre).
8. Entries: Close when full and will be accepted strictly in order of receipt. Entries will only be accepted on an official entry form sent to the sec of the meeting together with entry fee (payment by cheque or postal order only) and 3 Stamp addressed envelopes. All payments to **Dorset Police MCC**.
9. Non starters: Anyone who enters this event must give at least 7 days notice in writing of non attendance to be **considered** for a refund. An admin charge of £10:00 will be deducted from refunds.
10. Event Timing: Southern Counties Enduro Club (S.C.E.C.) will be timing the event using their transponder system. If you do not have S.C.E.C. transponder they will lend you one for the race. **YOU WILL NEED TO LEAVE A DEPOSIT OF £10:00, WHICH WILL BE RETURNED TO YOU WHEN YOU RETURN THE TRANSPONDER. YOU MUST TICK THE BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM IF YOU WANT TO BORROW ONE.**

ENTRY DECLARATION:

- I / we the undersigned apply to enter the event described and in consideration thereof: -
- I / we hereby declare that I / we have had the opportunity to read, and that I / we understand the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the ACU Standing Regulations, such Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event, and agree to be bound by them.
- I / we further declare that I am / we are physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am / we are competent to do so.
- I / we confirm that I / we understand the nature and type of event we are entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.
- I / we confirm that the machine(s) as described below which I / we compete on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose.
- I / we confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that it / they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.
- I / we agree that I am / we are required to register our arrival by "signing on" at the designated place not less than 30 minutes prior to commencement of my/our practice or first competition, whichever occurs first.

I / we enclose the entry fee of: **£38:00 (or £48:00 if on ACU day licence).**

Acknowledgement of the risks of motorsport: I / we understand that by taking part in this event I / we are exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I / we acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I / we may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my / our voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.

I / we have read the above and acknowledge that my / our participation in motorsport is entirely at my / our own risk.
