FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

VENUE: The Inside Park, near Blandford Forum. OS ref: ST 873045. Signed off the A354 1 mile South of Blandford

COURSE: A little over 6 miles in length and consisting of mostly flowing woodland tracks, paths and trails.

PARKING: Please park considerately and only where requested.

SIGNING ON: 9:00am to 10:00am. All riders must sign on before tech inspection.

IMPORTANT: Riders under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a Parent/Guardian who must sign the parental agreement form.

TRANSPONDERS: If you do not have a Kpeg Transponder and did not tick the box requesting one on the entry form please text Josie on 07846 695 137 immediately. No transponder = No ride ! Midwest transponders are fully compatible with our system.

PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO THE HIGH NUMBER OF LOAN TRANSPONDERS NOT BEING RETURNED WE NOW REQUIRE A DEPOSIT OF £20 (CHEQUE OR CASH) AGAINST THE SAFE RETURN OF YOUR TRANSPONDER.

TECH. INSPECTION: **9:00am to 10:00am.** Please push your machine to technical inspection. Machines will be placed in the start area immediately after scrutineering - **don't forget a stand!**

Helmets: Helmets must be Gold ACU approved and presented with machine.

Fire extinguishers: All riders must have a suitable fire extinguisher for use when refuelling.

Lights: Lights are not required. If your machine has glass lights please cover or remove them.

Numbers & Backgrounds. FRONT PLATES MUST HAVE THE CORRECT COLOUR BACKGROUNDS FOR YOUR CLASS. Side plate backgrounds must either be the correct colour or include your class prefix. Go to the 'General Information' section at enduro.org.uk for more info. In-Chains will be present and will have backgrounds and numbers available.



Tyres: Rear: TRIALS OR ENDURO SPEC. ONLY. The maximum tread depth must be 13mm anywhere on the tyre. Please be aware that the Michelin 'AC10' is a Moto-X tyre NOT an Enduro tyre and we don't allow them - no big knobs please! Front tyres are free choice. Golden Tyre enduro tyres will be available at sign on (see enduro.org.uk for details & prices)

Noise: Excessive noise is killing our sport. ONLY MACHINES THAT COMPLY WITH THE FIM ENDURO NOISE LIMIT WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT. To avoid any confusion please note that pre. 2008 four-stroke moto-x bikes fitted with standard pipes do not comply - they will not be noise tested and will not be allowed to compete.

Remember any official can exclude any excessively noisy machines at any time during the event so please ensure your tail pipe is well packed, your exhaust is in good condition and that all springs and fasteners are in place and secure.

RIDERS BRIEFING: The awards presentation and riders briefing will take place at 10:00. ALL RIDERS MUST ATTEND, this will be followed by an additional briefing for newcomers to the sport.

START: Dead engine wave start. Riders will start in waves at one-minute intervals. Riders will be permitted to warm their engines before the start.

REFUELLING: Refuelling must be carried out in the official refuelling area only. RIDING IS NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE REFUEL AREA. Failure to comply will result in immediate exclusion. Pit crew may assist their riders but spectators, children and pets are not permitted in the refuel or service areas. All riders must have a suitable fire extinguisher for use when refuelling.

RESULTS: Provisional results will be available immediately the last rider crosses the line. If you provided a mobile number you will also receive your result via text courtesy of Pro-Clean and the amazing

Influx Marketing text service. Full results including lap data will be posted on www.enduro.org.uk early evening.

- ACCIDENTS:** Injuries should be reported to the Secretary of the Meeting before leaving the venue.
- PARTS VAN:** In-Chains will be present with their trade van – if you need stuff for the race they'll happily bring it along for you to collect on race day. FREEPHONE In-Chains 0800 135 7032
- REFRESHMENTS:** Hot food and drinks will be available throughout the event – when you've enjoyed your food please put your rubbish in one of the bins provided.
- SMOKING:** Smoking is NOT PERMITTED anywhere at the venue.
- RUBBISH:** You will be presented with a bin-liner at signing on, please use it to take your rubbish home with you. ALL RIDERS ARE EQUALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CLEANLINESS OF THE SITE WHEN WE LEAVE - PLEASE PICK UP ANY LITTER AROUND YOUR VEHICLE BEFORE YOU GO – DON'T LEAVE IT FOR SOMEONE ELSE TO PICK-UP.
- TEAR OFFS:** Discarded goggle "tear-offs" are extremely hazardous to farm and wild animals and are not permitted at SCEC events. If you are caught using them you will be excluded from the results.
- COURSE CUTTING:** The penalty for course cutting or any other unsporting behaviour is immediate exclusion - no exceptions.
