FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

- VENUE:** Shillingstone Forest is approx. 3 miles Northwest of Blandford. Signed off the A357 at Durweston. OS ref: ST 835086.
- COURSE:** The course is approximately 8 miles in length and consists of woodland trails and paths with various natural obstacles.
- PARKING:** Parking at this venue is on the forest tracks - there is plenty of room if you all park sensibly. If you are able to double up on transport please do. **Make sure you leave room for emergency vehicles to pass!**
- SIGNING ON:** 8:45am to 10:00am. All riders must sign on before machine examination.
IMPORTANT: Riders under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a Parent/Guardian who must sign the parental agreement form.
- TRANSPONDERS:** If you do not have a Kpeg Transponder and did not tick the box requesting one on the entry form please text Josie on 07595 619370 immediately. No transponder = No ride! MidWest & West Wilts MCC transponders may be used and are fully compatible. **A £20 deposit is required against safe return of loan/rented transponders.** Note: You can only borrow once, after then you must rent (£5.00) or buy (£15.00).
- TECH. INSPECTION:** **9:15am to 10:15am** Please push your machine for inspection. Machines will then be placed in the start box so it needs to be ready to race (including fuel!) - don't forget to bring a stand!
- Helmets:** Helmets must be ACU approved and presented with machine. Helmets with thermo plastic shells must have the 'dual band' ACU stamp.
- Fire extinguishers:** All riders must have a suitable fire extinguisher for use when refuelling.
- Lights:** Lights are not required. If your machine has glass lights please cover or remove them
- Noise:** The standard FIM noise limit will be rigidly enforced. If your machine is found to be above this level you will not be allowed to participate.. All 4 stroke machines must run an Enduro or 'Q' pipe - eg: no moto-x pipes.
- Backgrounds:** Correct **front** colour backgrounds are obligatory. If you do not have the correct colour background you will be asked to start after the last line.
- Tyres:** **Rear: Trials pattern only** Front: free choice.
- SAFETY BRIEFING:** There will be a riders safety briefing & awards presentation at 10:30 Attendance is obligatory.
- START:** Dead engine wave start. Riders will start in waves by class at one-minute intervals. Riders will be permitted to warm their engines before the start.
- FINISH:** Riders should be aware that classes finish in waves as per the start - it is the rider's responsibility to ensure that he or she continues until their stipulated finish time. Timing marshals will assist when possible however if you have the incorrect backgrounds they will be unable to help. The SCEC live results system displays your provisional position each lap as you scan - results are published at www.enduro.org.uk.
- REFUELLING:** Refuelling must be carried out in the official refuelling area only. Riding is NOT permitted within the refuel area - failure to comply will result in immediate exclusion. Pit crew may assist their riders but spectators,

children and pets are not permitted in the refuel or service areas. All riders must have a suitable fire extinguisher for use when refuelling.

- PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY:** The course crosses several rights of way. These are BLUE TAPE areas and may be manned by marshals using STOP/GO boards. It is a condition of entry that you do not exceed walking pace in these areas and obey marshals instructions immediately and without question.
- WALKING PACE:** Riders must not overtake or exceed walking pace in any 'BLUE TAPE' or other designated 'WALKING PACE' area. The penalty for failing to comply with any safety instruction is immediate disqualification.
- PENALTIES:** All penalties/exclusions as per the SCEC Sporting Code and ESR's
- ACCIDENTS:** Injuries should be reported to the Secretary of the Meeting before leaving the venue.
- REFRESHMENTS:** Hot food and hot/cold drinks will be available throughout the event.
- SMOKING:** Smoking is NOT PERMITTED at the venue.
- RUBBISH:** Please take all your rubbish home with you. All riders are equally responsible for the cleanliness of the venue so please look around your vehicle and pick up any litter before you go - do not leave it for someone else to pick-up.
- COURSE CUTTING:** The penalty for course cutting or any other unsporting behaviour is immediate exclusion - no exceptions.
- TEAR OFFS:** "Tear-off" goggle lenses are not permitted at SCEC events. Start marshals will check for them before the start - riders attempting to use them will be penalised minimum 2 laps.

FOREST ACCESS & RIGHTS OF WAY

In addition enduro events may cross, run alongside, or even run along public rights of way and consequently you may come across walkers, cyclists or even horse riders on the course.
