Time Cards

Full details as to the purpose and use of time cards are contained within the ACU handbook on page 105 (ESR19), however in essence it is a record of your performance throughout the event. It must be correctly completed and presented to the time keepers at each check point for updating. At the end of the event it must be presented to the time keepers. If you retire you should write "retired" on the card

You fill in this column, the times are usually posted somewhere near the start or signing on desk.

You also fill out this column. Start time plus allowance and so on ...

This part must only be completed by the club officials. You must hand the card to them at each time control for it to be completed

Note you have arrived 11 minutes late at this check, but you are allowed one minute allowance (LAA), so you only get penalised for the other 10 minutes.

From now on you must arrive at 11 minutes later than your card shows ...

except at the final check when you can arrive early with no penalty

and hand it in. The penalty for altering the time card (ie: to show an improved performance over that actually achieved) is exclusion. Virtually all clubs (including ours) now use time cards provided free of charge by those really nice people at **Off-Road Only** (telephone 01597 851273). Every rider should have a copy of their mail order catalogue. If you don't have one phone them, and when you do, don't forget to thank them.

If you have an old (ACU) handbook, you should phone the ACU and ask for a new one (01788 566400), however, for reference purposes, the relevant pages and ESRs (Enduro Standing Regulation) for old handbooks are as follows:
